Background information

- The first is called *Roots* from Inscape Animations with free resources developed by Quaker Peace and Social Witness. It beautifully encapsulates the ideas that Seckou and his team have been exploring. The activities are designed for young people aged 11-14 and can be found here <https://www.tes.com/teaching-resource/download/12960274>. They are free to download. The video (see powerpoint for access) is suitable for slightly younger learners although care will be needed.
- The second is called *Our Story of Migration* from PositiveNegatives with free resources coming soon, developed by Lifeworlds Learning, also aimed at ages 11 and above. This animation tells stories of migration from the perspective of those living in the Global South. Four stories are included based on the real-life experiences of people migrating from Haiti to Brazil; Nepal to Malaysia; Burkina Faso to Cote d'Ivoire; Ethiopia to South Africa.
